

This small exhibition of original prints is intended to convey something of the style of the Ecole de Paris — a style which is by now almost international. The artists represented range from the masters — Picasso, Braque, Chagall, Leger, Rouault, Miro and Matisse to the younger artists who are making names for themselves to-day.

The original print has played an important part in contemporary art. Not only have the different media given the artist problems to solve, but there are major contributions to twentieth century art expressed solely in these media, for instance Rouault's Miserere series and Picasso's graphic work.

The original print is also a means of providing original works of art by important artists at a low cost. Thus the artist reaches out to a wider public and the private individual may, with a few pounds, provide himself with the stimulation only an original work of art may give.
