RECENT ACQUISITIONS WORKS ON PAPER

Auckland City Art Gallery
1977 — 1979

INTRODUCTION

This exhibition represents something less than a half of all prints, drawings watercolours and photographs acquired since the beginning of 1977. A selection of 150 individual works has been made from approximately 365 acquired over this period. All works are on paper with the exception of one which is screenprinted on vinyl. There is no painting or sculpture in the exhibition - a previous exhibition in March/April 1979 reviewed some recent acquisitions in those media.

A limited acquisitions budget has to be carefully managed to cover works in all the above mentioned media, both contemporary and historical, indigenous and foreign. Because it is sometimes better to concentrate on a specific area of purchasing at a time - for example contemporary New Zealand drawings - it is not always worthwhile to display acquisitions made a year at a time; this is the reason why this exhibition reviews three years of acquisitions. During this period attention has been given to various areas of the collection and an overall pattern in acquisitions has become apparent. To make this pattern more obvious works in the exhibition have been grouped according to school, medium and, to some extent, their historical context. New Zealand works in the various media occupy the whole of the Centre Gallery, while the West Gallery is given over entirely to foreign works. In the New Zealand section, prints, drawings and photographs have all been separated.

Although not all acquisitions made in the last two and a half years have been displayed - for reasons of practicality and space - all items acquired have been listed in the accompanying catalogue. Exhibited works are distinguished from non-exhibited works by an asterisk in the margin. In this way one can see at a glance that the four sketches by John Kinder in the exhibition are from a purchase of 29 sketches by the same artist. Where a set of images has been acquired - such as the portfolio of six organic screenprints by Edward Ruscha - the whole set has been displayed. However, occasionally the Gallery acquires incomplete sets of works (sometimes a single impression from a set of prints) which accounts for the fact that some items from sets are shown in isolation.

From time to time gifts of important works are made by generous individuals to the collection. Such works are identified by the name of the donor and the year in which they were presented.

This exhibition is purely a review of the acquisitions policy in the Department of Prints, Drawings and Photographs over the last two and a half years. Explanatory and didactic information has not been provided, this will be done when the works are selected for specific exhibitions.
