Knowing about your gift allows us to welcome you into our *Art for Always* family. It also allows us to administer your gift properly and thank you in your lifetime for your generosity and support.


If Auckland Art Gallery has been an important part of your life, we would love to welcome you into our family.

The finer points of gifting The detail Family first If you wish to leave the Gallery a gift in your will, you might consider the following text as a guide. We suggest you consult your lawyer or adviser, We encourage anyone thinking of leaving a gift to the Gallery to provide as the wording may need to be adapted for your situation and wishes. for their family before making a gift that supports our work. If your assets are held in a trust we suggest you talk to your lawyer or Financial gifts adviser about how your support of the Gallery might be provided for in your trust planning. Financial gifts in wills are ring-fenced and managed separately from the Gallery's day-to-day operations.
