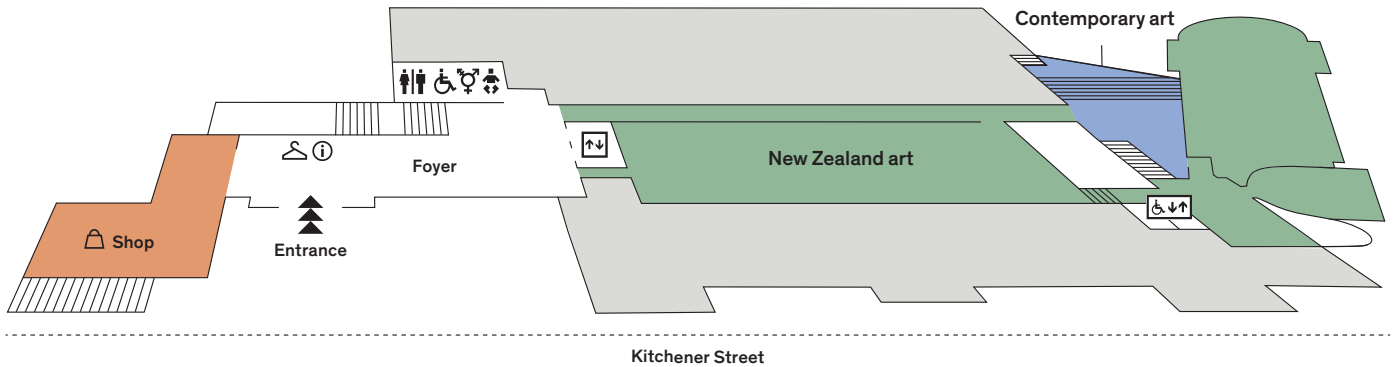

Take home a memory of the Toi o Tāmaki collection, support local artisans with a New Zealand made treasure to keep or give, and find your next great read from our curated selection of books.

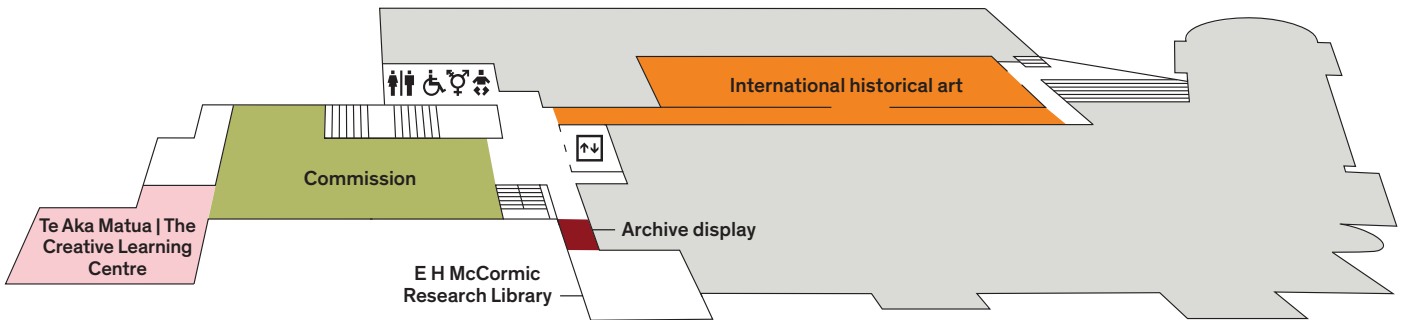
New Zealand art

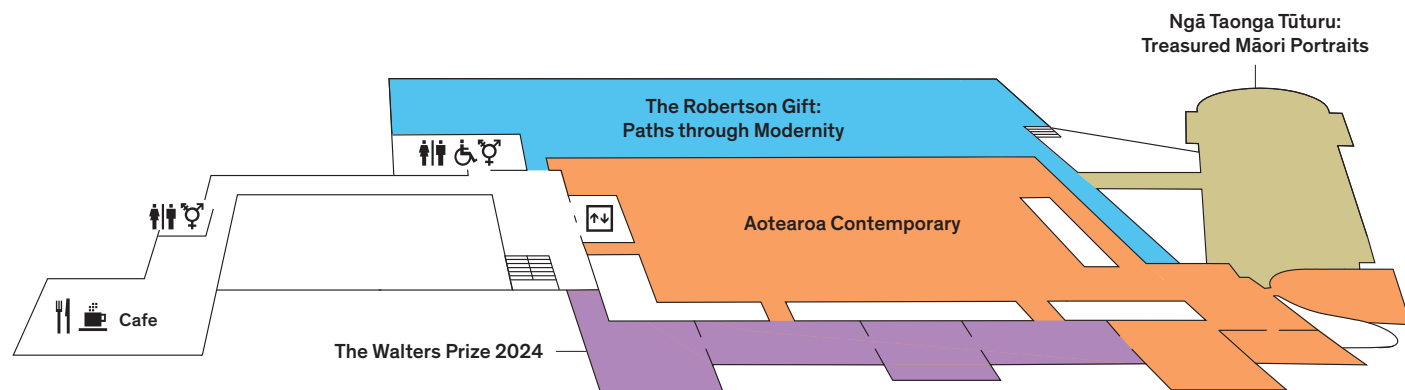

● Aotearoa Contemporary

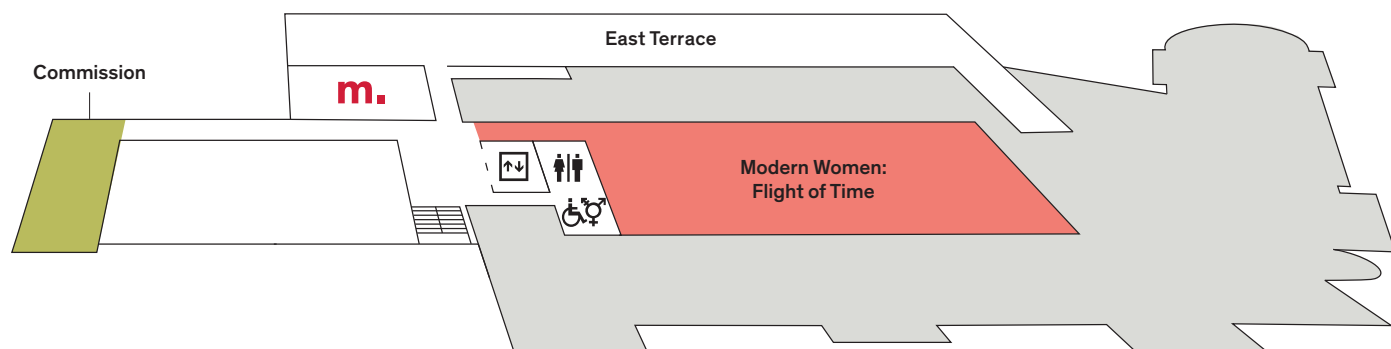
Until 20 Oct, be inspired by a new generation of local artists, showcasing works in painting, textiles, sculpture, ceramics, photography and choreographed performances.
