

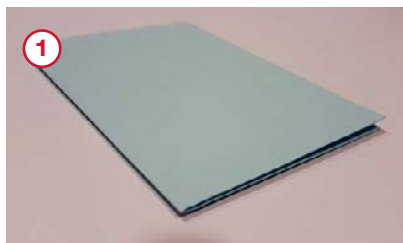

Materials

Different coloured paper, A4

Scissors

Glue stick



Lonnie Hutchinson-inspired layered cut out

Lonnie Hutchinson's artwork can be found cut into the thresholds between the old and new parts of Auckland Art Gallery's building. Laser cut in American oak, the work welcomes visitors into the space. Hutchinson uses repetition in these works and mirroring of simple forms. We are going to make our own versions using layered coloured paper and images of New Zealand.

Instructions:

- 1 Fold your paper into four.
- 2 Either draw or glue on your design. Work out from the folded edges. Make sure that there is at least one point of your design that touches each of the folded sides.
- 3 Cut out your design and unfold it.
- 4 Turn it over, glue and layer it onto a base paper. Choose colours that clash or complement. Add multiple cut-out layers. The options are limitless!
