

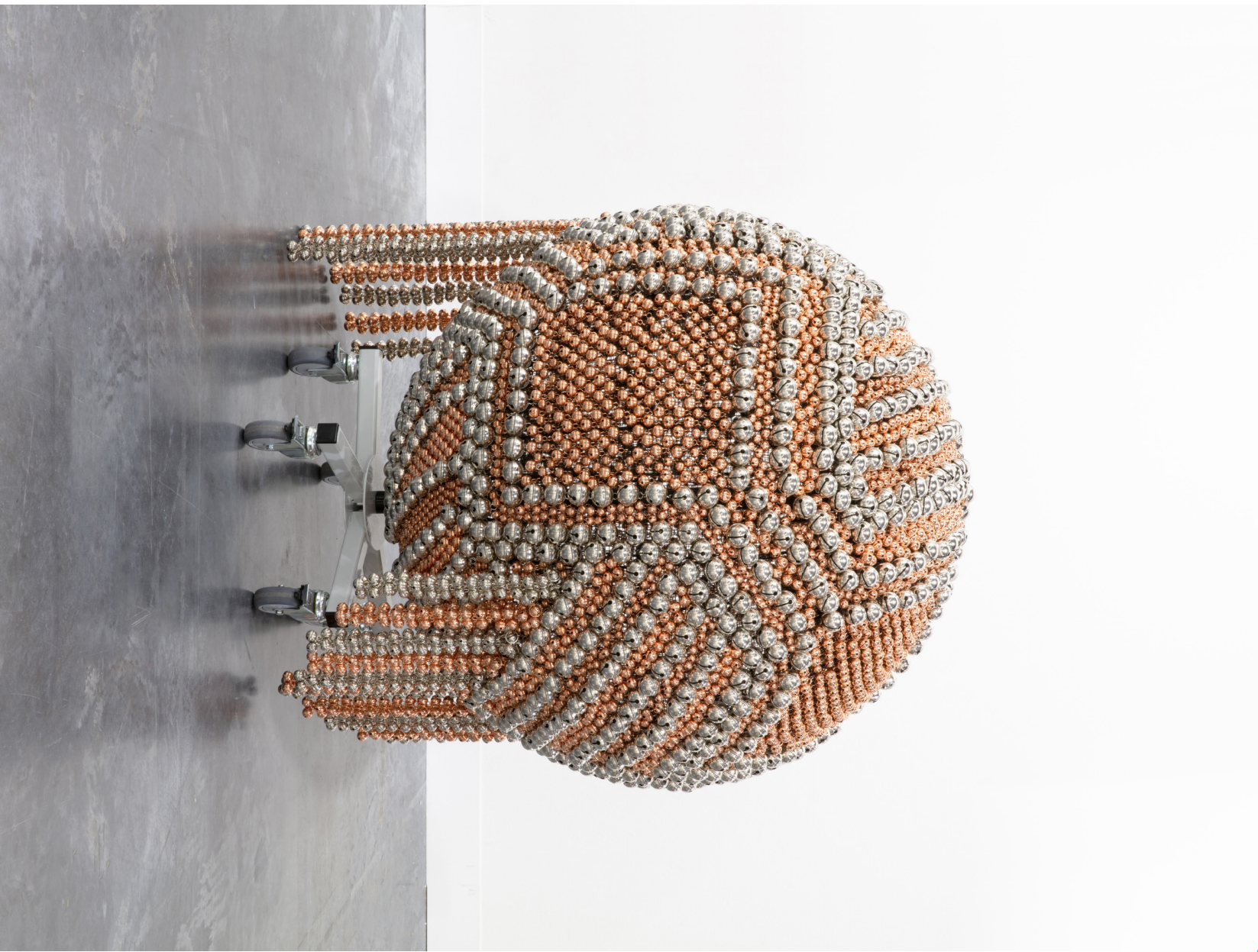

There are many ways to explore the Gallery – from following your own nose to following this map.

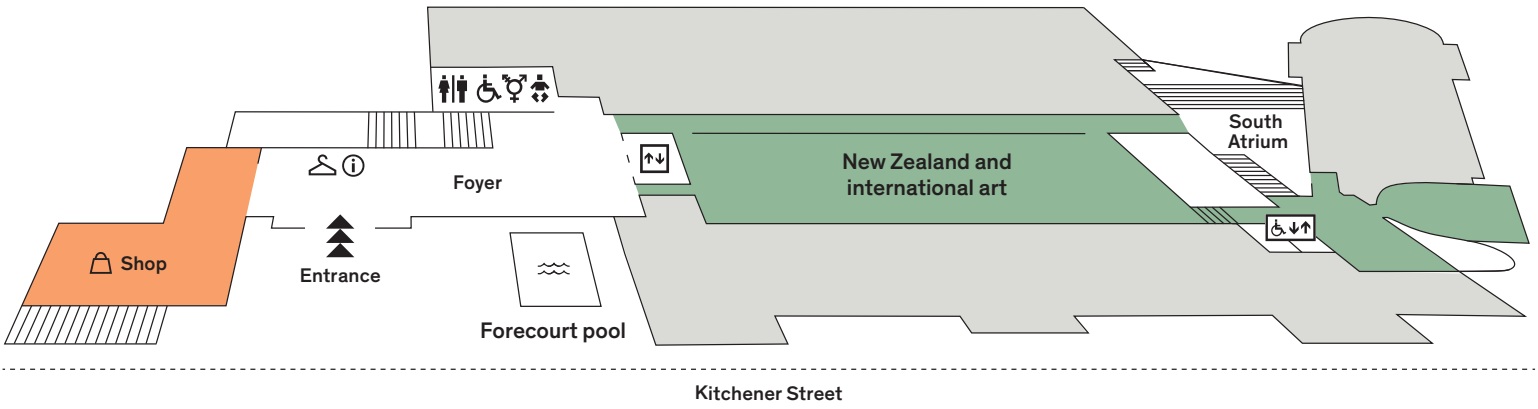

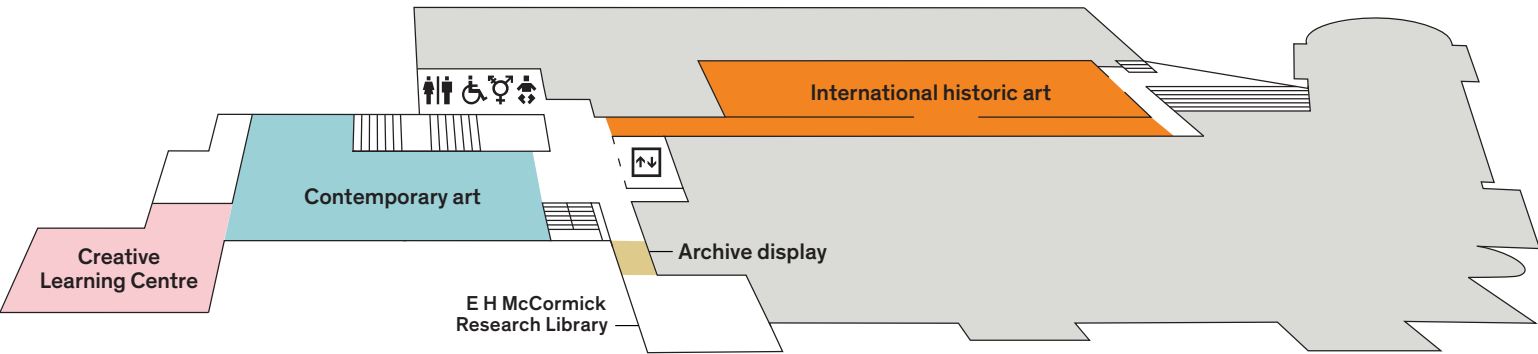
New Zealand and international art

Explore the interwoven threads between art and textiles across time, and immerse yourself in haunting worlds conjured by the gothic imagination.

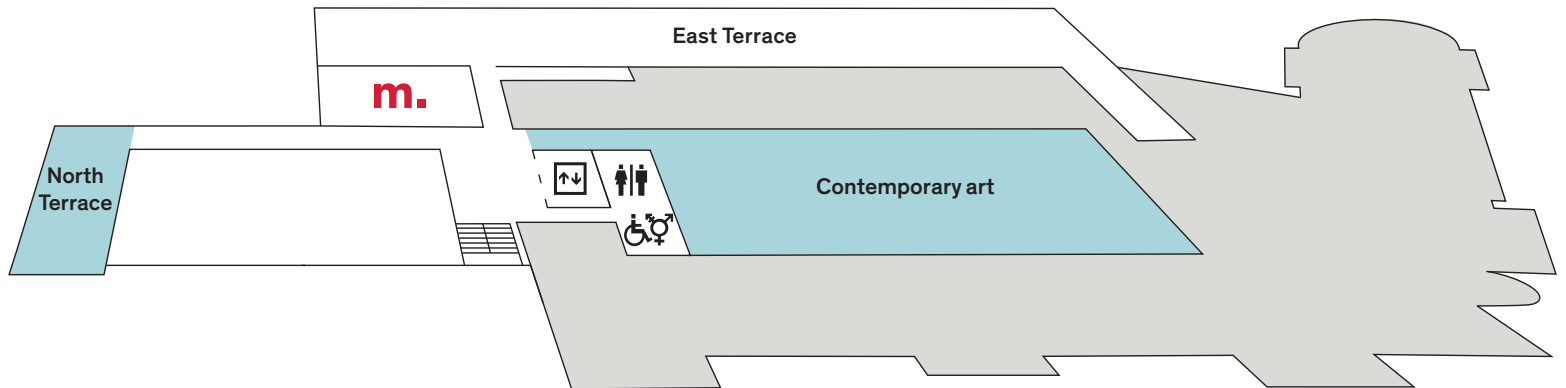
Kōeke 1 — Level 1
