

## 2024 INVITATION FOR THE PAT HANLY CREATIVITY PROJECT AND AWARDS

Auckland Art Gallery Toi o Tāmaki is excited to invite kaiako (teachers) to participate in the 2024 Pat Hanly Creativity Project and Awards.

As one of Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland's longest-standing creative youth art awards, this project celebrates our senior secondary school artists as well as one of Aotearoa New Zealand's most prolific artists: Pat Hanly.

This year we are inviting all secondary school art teachers who teach Y12 or 13 across Tāmaki Makaurau to participate! This comprehensive project includes an in-Gallery learning experience for you and your class, mentoring from Gallery staff at your school and an exhibition opening event for selected student artworks. We are excited to offer NCEA credits with this project as well, so sign up with your entire class.

## Part 1:

Sign up via the form <u>here</u> or the Pat Hanly Creativity Awards page on our website. The deadline to sign up is Monday 25 March, 2024.

The project will kick off with a two-hour Gallery led learning programme, held between May 20–31, 2024. We will work with you to book in your class to visit the Gallery during this two-week period.

## Part 2:

Take what you learned from your Gallery visit and apply it in your classroom. Akonga, students will develop their own original artwork back at school based on a theme explored at the Gallery. It could be a painting, a drawing, photograph, collage, or any other medium of their choice.

Gallery staff will visit your school to view participating students' artworks and provide feedback. This visit will be the basis for the judging process.

## Part 3:

The judges will select at least one student per school to take part in a special exhibition at Auckland Art Gallery Toi o Tāmaki. The selected artworks will be collected from your school to be taken to the Gallery.

All ākonga who have participated as well as their kaiako, friends and whānau will be invited to a celebration and exhibition opening event on Thursday 26 September, 6:00–8:00pm. (date might be subject to change)

We look forward to welcoming you into the Gallery and creating meaningful learning opportunities for you and your akong through art.
