

# **Performers**

## **James Flores**



James Flores is based in Albury, NSW, Australia. His musical journey began with piano lessons at the age of 4, but the organ became his main focus in 2011.

James passed his LTCL examination with Distinction from London's Trinity College, gained his Licentiate Diploma with Honours in organ from the St Cecilia School of Music in NSW, received an archbishop's award for Church Music (Guild of Church Musicians) and in 2020 won a Governor-General of Australia medal for his contribution to music.

He has performed at many Australian churches and has given recitals in Lithuania and the United States of America.

His aim is to enrich lives through the power of organ music with live concerts and via a comprehensive library on Youtube.

# **Soomin Kim**



Soomin Kim is an organist and pianist based in Auckland. She performs regularly at All Saints Anglican Church Ponsonby and Pitt St Methodist Church, and has been collaborating with Auckland Philharmonia on both instruments.

Born in Korea, Soomin began learning piano at the age of six. After moving to NZ in 2013, she studied Classical Performance at the University of Auckland. There, she was introduced to the organ! A winner of many prizes, Soomin is an accompanist for a number of Auckland choirs including The Graduate Choir NZ.

# The Graduate Choir New Zealand



Terence Maskell is the Artistic Director and Conductor of The Graduate Choir New Zealand. He gained his early choral and musical development from Emeritus Professor Peter Godfrey and Anthony Jennings.

He has a distinguished career as choral director and music teacher at several Auckland schools – his choirs regularly winning the highest accolades for choral excellence.

Maskell established The Graduate Choir New Zealand in 2001. It is one of the pre-eminent mixed-voice choirs in New Zealand, earning

high acclaim both here and abroad for its unique warmth of sound and breadth of repertoire. The singers represent Auckland's wide cultural and ethnic mix.

Distinguished alumni include international opera stars Pene and Amitai Pati who began singing with the choir as teenagers.
