We All Stand Together: The Secret Piano Bar is like karaoke, but cool. And with audience participation. "It's exactly the vibe a festival should have. At the end of the night, people sitting round a piano going, 'What about this song?' Then jumping on the piano and having a singalong."

You're Only Human: The best punters aren't afraid to make mistakes. "You need someone who's going to get up there and deliver without worrying about getting it right."

Go Your Own Way: The songs won't sound the way they do on the radio. "If you're someone who needs the song to sound exactly the way you want it, this isn't for you."

Bring 'Em All In: Budding songwriters, feel free to suggest your own music. "It's lovely when people come up and say, 'I have this song I wrote, can I have a go?"

You're Just Too Obscure For Me: The oldies are often the goodies. "Don't be afraid of the classics. I've put some obscure stuff in the book but Abba is great music and famous ballads are fun."

Come As You Are: It's an opportunity to dress for an occasion, so feel free to don a fabulous frock or your Sunday best. Or don't. You do you.
