Learn about famous explorers with a connection to New Zealand. In this educator-led workshop, students will have the opportunity to examine the dangers, difficulties and the amazing accomplishments of explorers throughout time.

The workshop includes a screening of Te Waka, an immersive animated masterpiece showing the Pacific migration of the early Polynesians, and is followed by a self-guided trail to discover the rest of the Museum's collection. Students will work in small groups, led by their adult supervisors, to follow their own interests and learn at their own pace.
