PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Discover Kupe, Captain James Cook, Sir Peter Blake, surf life savers and world-beating Olympians!

This educator-led workshop will challenge students to explore what it means to be a hero, introduce them to key figures in Aotearoa New Zealand's history and inspire them to recognise the heroic characteristics in themselves and others.

The workshop is followed by a self-guided trail to discover the heroes in Hui Te Ananui A Tangaroa, the New Zealand Maritime Museum's collection. Students will work in small groups, led by their adult supervisors, to follow their own interests and learn at their own pace.
