In 2023, to mark 100 years since Ernest Shackleton's final polar expedition, the Antarctic Heritage Trust took a group of young people to the subantarctic island of South Georgia as part of its Inspiring Explorers™ Programme.

Among those who had their minds blown were four artists: Tegan

Allpress (Te Arawa, Rongowhakaata), Peregrin Hyde (Ngāti Maniapoto), Rose Lasham, and Charlie Thomas.

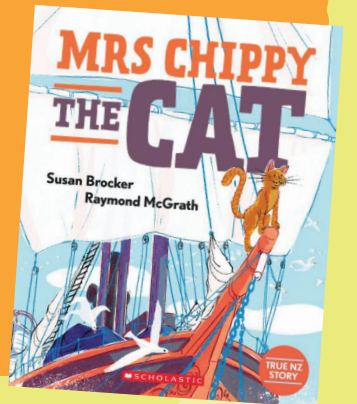
