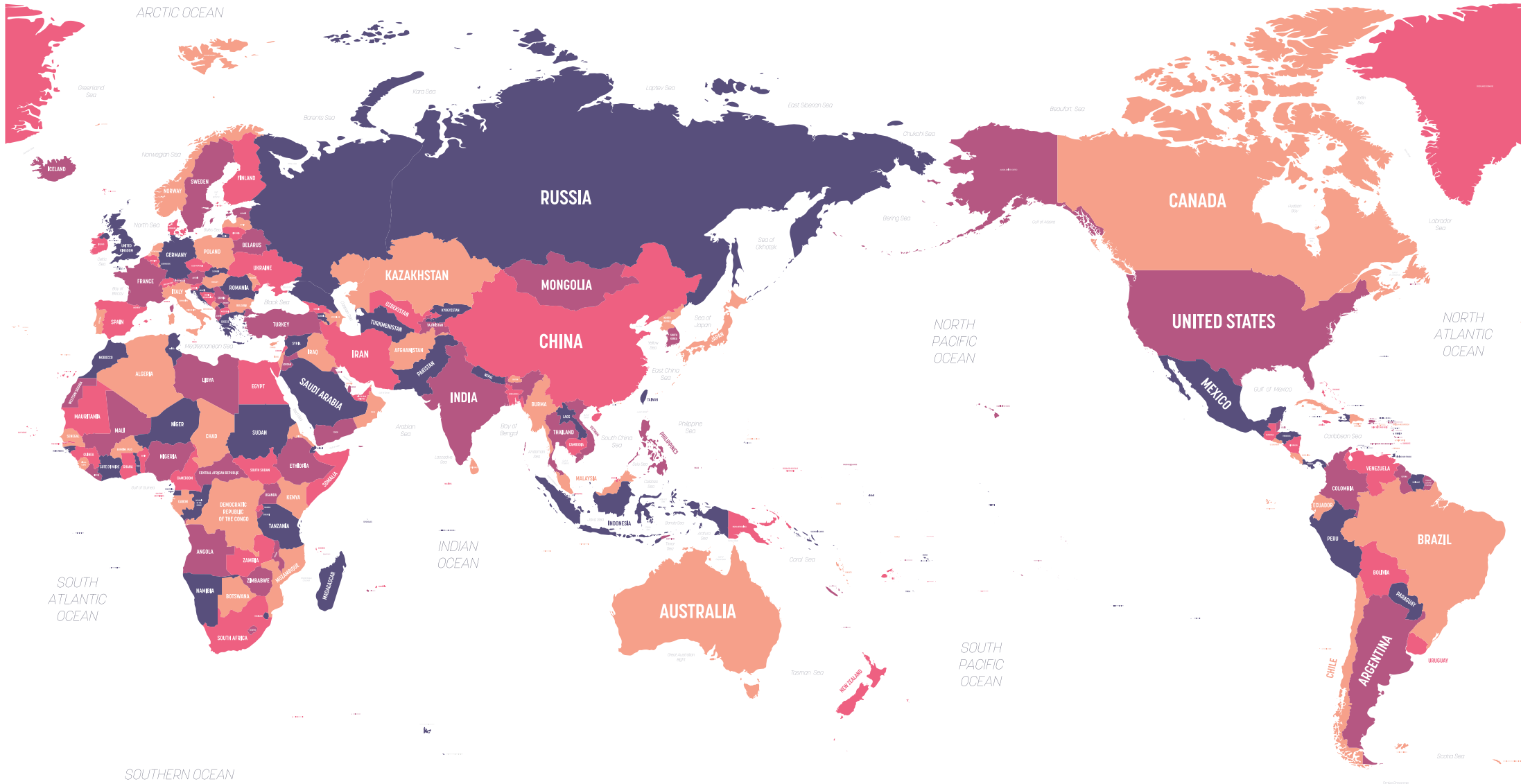

Tāmaki Makaurau has over 200 different cultures living here. Research one of these groups and answer the questions below.

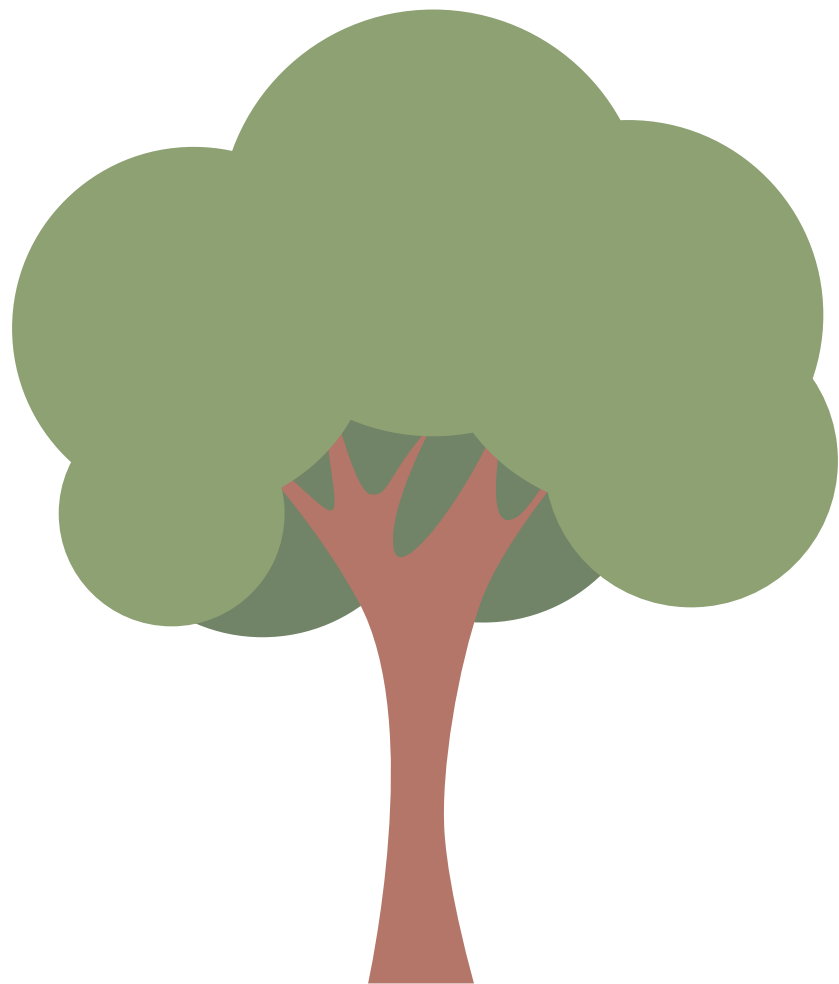
Who are they? Where did they come from?

What happened once they arrived? Where did they settle? What jobs did they do?

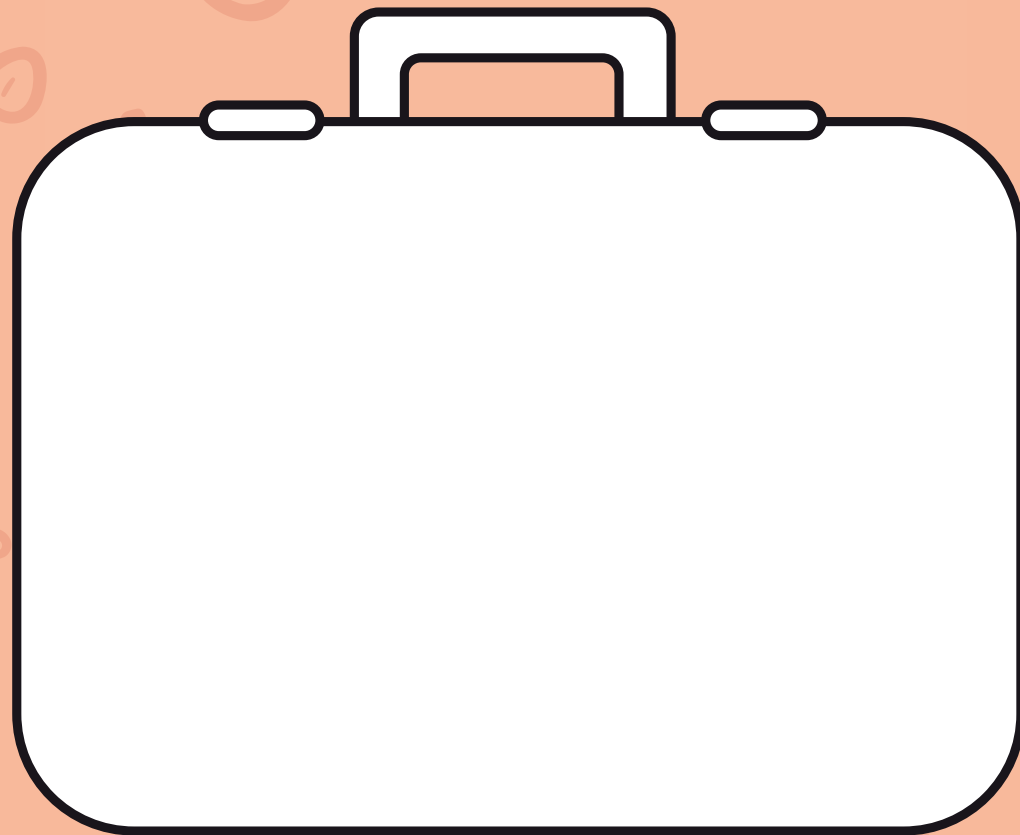
