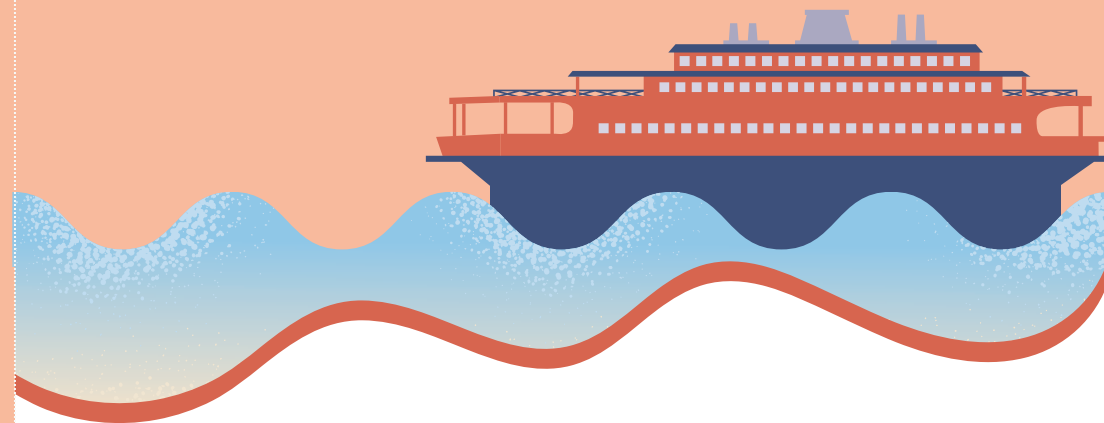
VOCABULARY BUILDER

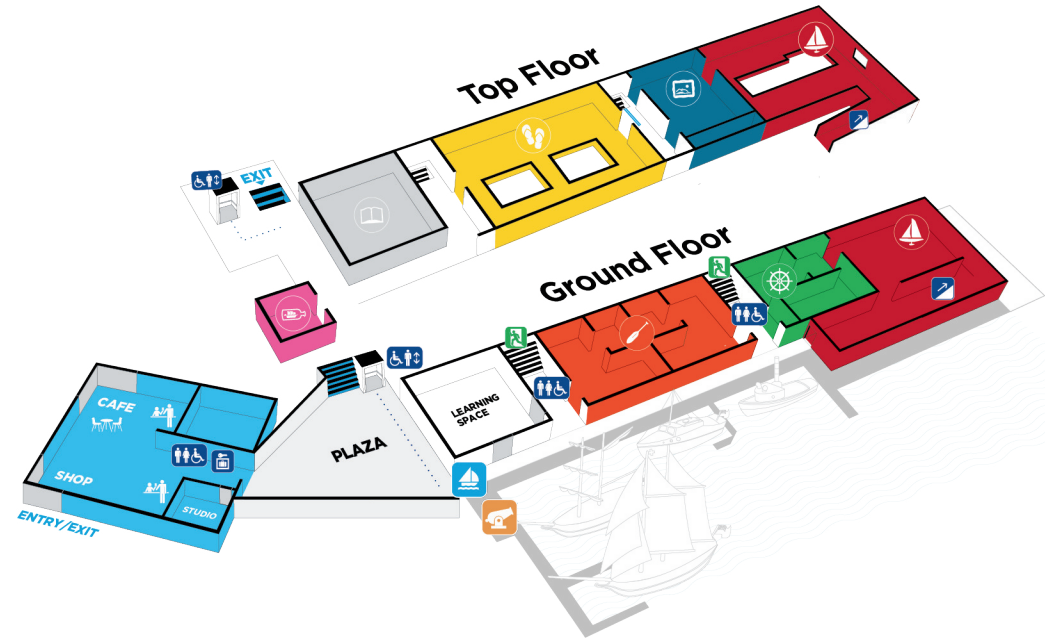
