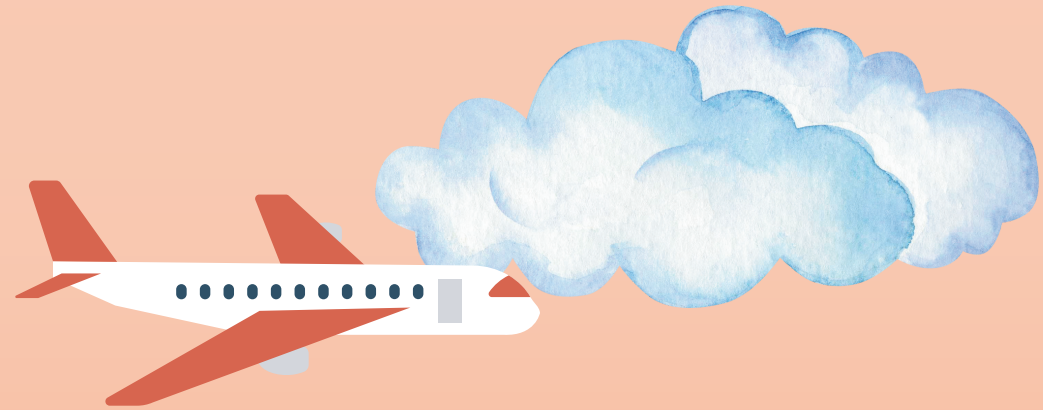


IMMIGRATION GLOSSARY

Migration	Movement from one place to another.
Immigration	Travelling into a country to live.
Emigration	Exiting one country to live somewhere else.
Push factor	Something that makes people want to leave their home.
Pull factor	Something that attracts people to a place.
Refugee	A person who has been forced to leave their country.
Tangata Whenua	First peoples of Aotearoa New Zealand.
