This letter is to let you know about the upcoming music event taking place at Western Springs Park Lakeside and Western Springs Stadium.

The Event

The area around the venue will be busier than usual on this day. Parking restrictions and road closures will be in place to ensure the safe delivery of this event.

Please note: Patrons will be accessing this event via two gates – one on Stadium Road and one on Old Mill Road. Use of the Old Mill Road gate will see more patrons on the street in this area, alongside an additional security presence.

Access to your business

If your business premises is within a road closure, your employees will still be able to access your premises. If staff are not driving a branded vehicle, please provide them with a form of identification such as a company uniform, letterhead or business card to present to traffic controllers/ Police / security at the road closure point.

Please Note: If you expect your business needs to breach the road closures then please contact us directly via info@aucklandstadiums.co.nz prior to event day.

Access to your property

If your property is within a road closure, you will still be able to access your premises. Please present traffic controllers / police / security a valid proof of address at the road closure point. Please note that parking restrictions will still apply, so on-road parking may still be restricted. Please check for signage indicating traffic restrictions in the days leading up to the event. Additional Security Support

We appreciate the disruption that events can bring to residents so have coordinated with our security team for patrols on external roads. Noise Levels & Pyrotechnics

The noise levels of this concert will be monitored to ensure that they are within appropriate limits.

Please note: These shows will also contain planned pyrotechnics throughout the show. Please expect heightened noise levels during the event period.

Temporary Liquor Ban

A temporary liquor ban will be in place on the streets surrounding the venue from *6.00am on event day until 6.00am the following day*. Police will be actively monitoring public areas around the venue and enforcing the ban.

Waste Management

Waste management personnel will be moving through the immediate neighbourhood surrounding the stadium during the event and after, collecting any event-related rubbish. If your property is impacted, then please notify us via email.
