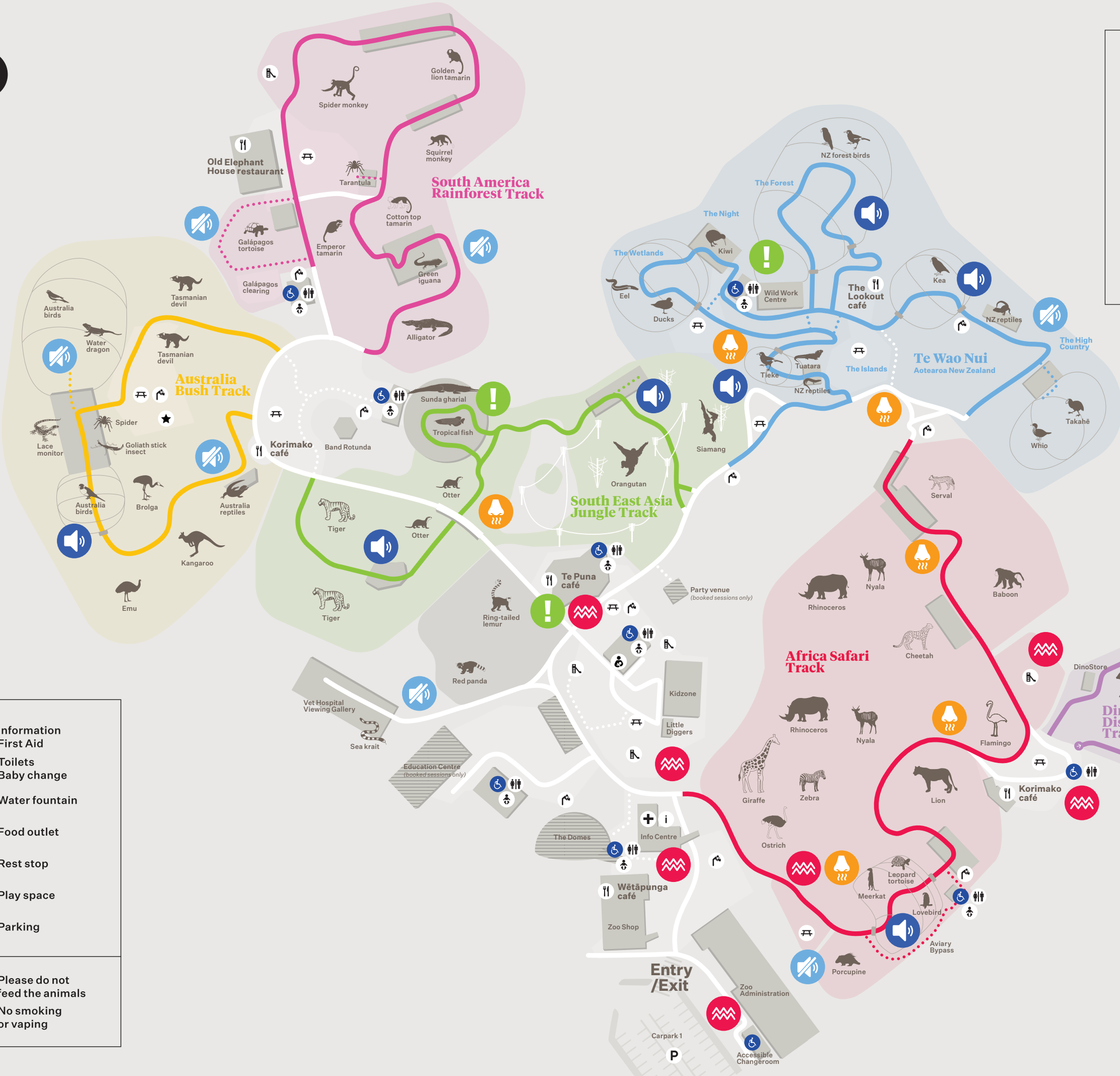

This place is indoors and dark. It is quiet and calm. Your eyes may need time to adjust. Hold your adult's hand and walk slowly.

! Swamp Forest

This place is hot and steamy. You may smell strong smells. You may hear animal sounds. Sometimes it rains inside. If it feels too much, it's okay to leave.
