



Located on the South America Rainforest Track, our iconic Old Elephant House has been transformed into a dine-in restaurant featuring a fresh salad and protein bar, a wide range of beverages and café fare.

open Sat-Sun 11:00am-3:00pm* (every day during school holidays)

Located in Te Wao Nui, The Lookout offers waffles, coffee, cold drinks and Kāpiti ice creams.

Located opposite the band rotunda, this small pop-up café offers American hot dogs, takeaway coffee and scoop ice cream.
