Wētāpunga café open until 5:30pm

Wētāpunga café offers dine-in coffee, along with artisan sandwiches, delicious baked treats, and toasties.

Te Puna café open until 5:30pm

Located in the heart of the Zoo, enjoy a dine-in coffee, and a wide range of hot and cold café food while looking out over the lake into South East Asia.

Mokonui café open 10:00am–4:00pm*

Take in stunning views of flamingos and lions while you enjoy 'dine-in' coffee, ice cream, burgers, hot chips and cold drinks.

Old Elephant House restaurant open Fri-Sun 10:30am–2:30pm*

Located on the South America Rainforest Track, our iconic café invites you to unwind in a relaxed setting. Indulge in a tempting à la carte menu on weekends and in school holidays, or grab a fresh sandwich, salad, or sweet treat on the go.

The Lookout café open Sat-Sun 11:00am–3:00pm*

Located in Te Wao Nui, The Lookout offers coffee, cold drinks and Kāpiti ice creams. Bring your own reusable cup.

Korimako café open 11:00am–4:00pm*

Located opposite the band rotunda, this small pop-up café offers American hot dogs, coffee and scoop ice cream. Bring your own reusable cup.

Our cafés source products from local suppliers wherever we can, and any products that use palm oil contain only Certified Sustainable Palm Oil (CSPO) that's rainforest and wildlife friendly.

To reduce the use of single-use plastic, we no longer sell bottled water. Stay hydrated, look out for water refill stations around the Zoo or stop in at a café.

Hot drinks

Single-use coffee cups have gone for good from the Zoo. But don't worry - you can still dine-in at Wētāpunga café, Te Puna café, Mokonui café and Old Elephant House restaurant, or bring your own reusable cup to get a discount on your hot drink!
